Job Title:

Bridge Controller

Organisational Reporting Line

Reports to Operations and Maintenance Coordinator.

Purpose / Role

To control the number of personnel transiting from Accommodation & Support Vessel (ASV) to Drilling & Production Platform (DPP) to ensure the assigned limits are adhered to.

A member of the AIM campaign team with special responsibility for personnel control at the bridge.

Prime Responsibilities and Duties

- To be aware of the allowable number of personnel allowed across the bridge to DPP at any time of the shift
- To notify the ASV to AIM Campaign Superintendent (or his delegate) of any problems arising at the crossing point.
- To communicate via radio handset to ASV heli admin as required
- To informally check personnel to make sure they are wearing the minimum PPE before transiting to DPP (Boots, Coverall, glasses, hard hat & hearing protection. (No dark glasses on night shift)
- Verify all personnel are carrying their pass cards - or the instrument for what ever other method of monitoring is used.
- Report any faults in equipment immediately to the Campaign Superintendent (or his delegate).
- Assist in Coordinating coverage for meal, comfort & rest breaks to ensure the bridge is never left un-attended
- Participate as directed in any special safety musters.
- To work day or night shift as required

Knowledge and Skills

- Good oral communication skills – willingness and ability talk in English
- Ability to record notes, understand check-sheets and operate simple machines e.g. radio hand sets.
- Understanding of PPE, its purpose and proper condition.

Experience / Qualifications

- **Position opened for Timorese Nationals Only**
- **No formal qualifications required other than willingness to work offshore and on a 3 weeks on 3 weeks off roster.**
- **No former experience required**

Personal Attributes

- Ability to work on own initiative.
- Ability to maintain a post for extended periods of time
- A willingness to undertake other minor opportunity jobs that can be done at the post – without leaving it.
- Reliable and responsible.
- Act safely at all times.

Work Requirements

- Role requires individuals to work an offshore rota and shift system and/or an onshore standby and call-out system.
- Role can be either night or day shift.
- Current Offshore Survival Certification. BOSIET – to be provided by Caltech
- Current Medical Certification. – to be provided by Caltech
- Must be able to work alone at times..
- Must comply with the requirements of the Offshore Safety Management System (SMS).
